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


Einstein on Wine set for November 18

259 children from 207 families attended North Dakota's Gateway to Science camps this summer.

STEM Adventure Camp for grades 1-5 saw 211 students over 11 weeks. Some campers attended one week and others joined us multiple weeks.



Three weeks of STEM Camp for grades 6-9 were attended by 48 different students. The middle school camps offer more career exploration in focused areas. This summer's middle school camps were held at the BPS Career Academy, DCN (technology focus), and Ducks Unlimited (environmental science focus).

All of our summer camps include activities led by guest presenters from businesses, organizations, and public offices in our community. We thank all of these STEM professionals who took the time to be a part of our camps and share their expertise with our campers.
