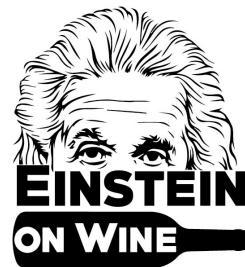
## **Einstein on Wine silent auction open**

## **NASA's Edward Gonzales visits ND**

Presentations in Bismarck and New Town

Last month, North Dakota's Gateway to Science hosted Edward "Eddie" Gonzales from Goddard Space Flight Center for a two-day speaking tour in Bismarck and New Town. During his visit to North Dakota, Gonzales spoke to the elementary and middle schools in New Town, several MHA treatment recovery centers, and a Visiting Scientist Series public presentation held at United Tribes Technical College.





Gonzales shared that not all paths to NASA are linear and that anyone can work for NASA and make changes for STEM. He highlighted the need for new, fresh views and encouraged all diversities and educational backgrounds to join the NASA family. His story inspired all ages and his two-day tour sparked curiosity and discovery. Students asked for many "selfies" and autographs during his visit and he expressed he was humbled by the North Dakota hospitality from everyone. Special thanks to United Tribes Technical College and Visiting Scientist Series for co-sponsoring his visit.



Gonzales' visit complemented a space and aeronautics Family Night at Edwin Loe Elementary School in New Town. Gateway to Science and the ND Space Consortium delivered hands-on activity stations for the event sponsored by a grant from NASA.
