STEM Adventure Club and Mini-Camps

STEM Adventure Mini-Camps are held during the school year on select days when there is no school (NDGTS follows the Bismarck Public School District calendar).

Mini-camps are scheduled for Monday and Tuesday, January 16 and 17, 2023. Camp runs from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm. The January mini-camps will be held at the



current location, 1810 Schafer Street, Bismarck.

Registration for each mini-camp day is \$72 for Gateway to Science members; \$90 for non-members.

STEM Adventure Club for grades 1–5 meets on Tuesdays from 4:00 pm to 5:15 pm beginning January 10, 2023. Club sessions will be held at the current location, 1810 Schafer Street, Bismarck. Parents will be notified when the meeting location moves to the new building (1600 Canary Ave).
