WHAT IT LOOKS LIKE

Instruction

As a STEM Summer Camp Instructor, you'll lead groups of students in exciting, hands-on STEM activities, teaching them new concepts in a fun and interactive way. You'll have the opportunity to engage with campers in various activities, including experiments, engineering challenges, and more.

Camp Prep, Deconstruction, and Supervision

Before and after each camp day, you'll help prepare and deconstruct materials for the day's activities, ensuring everything is ready for the next session. You'll also assist with camper supervision during lunch and outdoor time, support classroom management, and ensure a safe and enjoyable learning environment.

Visitor Guide Support

When not supporting summer camps, you'll help create a welcoming and engaging experience for visitors in our exhibits gallery. You'll greet guests, answer questions, and encourage exploration of hands-on STEM exhibits for visitors of all ages. You may help visitors operate interactive exhibits, guide them through activities like flight simulations, and help ensure the gallery remains a safe, fun, and inspiring environment.

This role shifts based on the needs of our programs—during busy camp weeks you may spend more time working with campers, while other weeks you may spend more time helping visitors explore the gallery.

- Has a passion for STEM education and working with kids in grades 1-6.
- Is dependable, responsible, and adaptable in a dynamic camp setting.

- Can effectively manage groups and encourage learning in a fun, engaging way.
- Is willing to ask questions, think critically and creatively to solve problems, acts quickly to prevent issues, and applies feedback.

This position works with STEM Educators and reports to the Onsite and Offsite Education Directors. Other duties not covered in this application may be assigned during work but will not exceed reasonable STEM Summer Camp Instructor responsibilities.

- The starting wage for this position is \$17/hour.
- Camps run the week of Memorial Day through August 15th , with hours between 7:45 AM to 5:15 PM.
- The position starts May 26th, with late afternoon/early evening training provided the week before.
